## Dear Dr Roberts

As you are aware, the *Electricity Act 1994* requires electricity retailers to include in household electricity bills, a statement including an estimation of the annual dollar impact of carbon tax and renewable energy target (RET) costs on a typical household. The statement itself is prescribed in the *Electricity Regulation 2006* and is intended to be updated for each financial year based on the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA) estimation for that financial year.

For the purposes of the regulatory requirement for 2014–15, I am directing the QCA under section 253AA of the *Electricity Act 1994* to provide an estimation, in the form of a single dollar figure, of estimated carbon tax costs plus RET costs and an estimation, expressed in megawatt hours, of the annual consumption of a typical household.

I would appreciate it if the QCA would provide the requested advice to me when it makes its final determination on notified prices for 2014–15.
