Dear Sirs,

I am very disappointed to find that anyone connected with control of water pricing + distribution could propose such a possible price increase in the cost of water for the Mt Larcom Township; we can not afford that cost. Mt Larcom previously had its own water scheme from a large lagoon; when the cement co. came to the area they required water from the Gladstone scheme + a Government department suggested they make a branch connection to feed our scheme from their reservoir; we still had to chlorinate this raw water; now all the water to here is treated in Gladstone. We may have to revert back to the original scheme + add filtration.

I think water should be treated like some services, letter postage + electricity charges and as in law we are all equal.

Through the time of drought we were encouraged to conserve water + did so, now the water authority can't sell enough water to pay their way + we are ~~still~~ being penalised because of this.
