

# GAWB bulk water price monitoring investigation for 2026–30

## 27 June 2025

We are starting a price monitoring investigation into Gladstone Area Water Board's (GAWB's) bulk water pricing practices, as directed by the Queensland Government pursuant to section 23A of the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1997*. The objective of the investigation is to make findings on appropriate prices relating to water security assets for the price monitoring period (1 July 2026 to 30 June 2030).

Public involvement is an important part of our review process, and all stakeholders, including members of the community, are encouraged to participate in our review. **Stakeholders are invited to make submissions by 20 October 2025.** There will be a further opportunity to make submissions after we release our draft report later this year.

We have published an information notice on our website to assist stakeholders with their submissions and explain our general approach to the review. **GAWB's submission is due by 26 August 2025.** We will publish GAWB's submission on our website as soon as possible after it is received.
