The Queensland Competition Authority (the Authority) is investigating the irrigation water prices to apply to seven Seqwater water supply schemes from 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2017.

On 13 February 2013, the Authority completed its second round of consultation which focussed on the Authority's Draft Report and Draft Prices.
